COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will provide students with psychoanalytic insights and ideas regarding substance abuse/addictions. Applications of these concepts will be discussed using clinical work from the instructor, as well as from class participants.

2. To identify how these ideas broaden treatment options in working with substance abuse and addiction.
3. To analyze when psychoanalytic thinking can best influence the clinical treatment of clients suffering with substance abuse and addiction.
