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### **Using Empathy: Insights from Self Psychology, a Study Group & Case Consultation 2/10/18 with Judy Zevin, PsyD**

#### COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides an introduction to the use of empathy in clinical work, using concepts from Self Psychology and an emphasis on clinical application. Participants will be provided with introductory material and asked to read it beforehand. They're also invited to consider case material to bring to class. There will be an opportunity for participants to share their own work in light of the group's reading and discussion.

#### COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To explain the language and elemental concepts of Self Psychology, including empathy, selfobject, transmuted internalization, mirroring, idealizing, twinship transferences, etc.
2. To integrate and utilize these concepts to think about the relationships we have with our patients and in understanding human behavior.
3. To discuss these concepts' impact on our work with our patients.
